All riders 18 and under must wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet.

# CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Age as of January 1, 2010

Ground-Pole Division – (1, 2, 5) Open to all riders. Poles placed on ground at each standard. Horse/rider combination are not eligible for other divisions except beginner. *Course to be trotted only.* Minimum 4 fences.

Beginner Rider/Horse – (3, 4, 6) Fences 12" and under. Horse/rider combination are not eligible for classes over 12". *May trot or canter course.*

Open Pony Division (8, 9, 14) All ages, minimum 8 fences, maximum height 18". *Course must be cantered.*

Adult Low Hunter Division (10,11,15) – Riders 18 and over. Maximum height 18". Minimum of 8 fences.

Youth Division (12, 13, 16) – Riders 16 & under. Maximum height 18". Minimum of 8 fences.

Equitation Division (17, 18, 21) – Open to all riders. Maximum height 2'. Minimum of 8 fences.

Green Division (19, 20, 22) – Green horse/riders. Maximum height 2'. Minimum of 8 fences.

Junior/Amateur Division (23, 24, 27) – Riders 18 & under, and non-professional riders over 19. Maximum height 2'6". Minimum of 8 fences.

Open Division (25, 26, 28) – Open to all riders. Maximum height 2'6". Minimum of 8 fences.

(Will increase division height upon request.)

Lead-Line – Ages 3-7 years old. May not enter other classes.

\*There shall be one number issued per each horse/rider combination.

\* Please note: Fences may be lower than heights listed above and the jumping efforts required may be more than the minimum number of fences listed above.

\* Manners will be emphasized in all classes and extreme speed will be penalized.

## RULES:

Age as of January 1, 2010.

No alcohol allowed – Please no dogs

Ponies to be 58" and under.

No trophy given unless there are 4 or more riders in a given class.

One (2) minute time limit on gate calls–Rider will be disqualified. Will be enforced.

Schooling in the arena from 7:00 A.M. to 7:45 A.M.

Hard hats to be worn while mounted.

Courses will be posted before show starts.

Questions or protests should be made with the technical delegates.

Protests will be made by making a \$5.00 deposit. If the protest is valid, the deposit will be returned.

All division classes must be entered prior to first division class call.

Both over fence courses may be ridden consecutively if entered, and acknowledged by gateman.

After third refusal, horse is to be excused, politely!
