| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Helmets are required for ages 18 and under any time exhibitor is in the arena. • Exhibitor age as of January 1 of this year. • Riders under 18 must have parent or guardian sign entry. • Proper attire required for all English and Western classes. • No entries taken after previous class enters. • For classes with fewer than 5 entries, the show committee has the right to combine, cancel, or substitute classes. • Novice classes are for horse/rider combinations who have never won a 1st place in that class, at ANY show prior to today's date. • No trophy or year-end high points given unless there are 4 or more riders in a class. • No hitting or abuse of horses will be tolerated. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All horses must provide proof of a current negative Coggins. • No stallion age 2 or over may be shown by anyone under 18. • No alcohol. • Dogs must be on a leash and kept away from horses. • The Show Committee reserves the right to excuse any exhibitor, spectator, or equine from the grounds. • Spring Grove Horse Show, Inc., the Village of Spring Grove, and all other affiliates are not responsible or liable for any injury, damages, or loss sustained in any way to exhibitors, volunteers, spectators, or properties. • Spectators are expected to remain in designated areas. • Covid waiver may be required. • In case of a division tie, Showmanship class points will be used as a tie-breaker for divisional high point awards. |

The focus of the judging will be on the riding and on the ranch-style movement of the horse. Horse/Rider combination may participate in other classes. Banding/braiding will be allowed for riders participating in classes other than Ranch.
