FREE GENERAL ADMISSION

- Helmets are required for ages 18 and under any time exhibitor in the arena.
- Exhibitor age as of January 1 of this year.
- Riders under 18 must have parents or guardian sign entry.
- Formal attire not necessary, long pants recommended, boots required.
- No entries taken after previous class enters.
- For classes with fewer than 5 entries, the show committee has the right to combine, cancel, or substitute classes.
- No trophy or year-end high points given unless there are 4 or more riders in a class.

- All horses must provide proof of a current negative Coggins.
- No stallion age 2 or over may be shown by anyone under 18.
- No alcohol.
- Dogs must be on a leash and kept away from horses.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to excuse any exhibitor, spectator, or equine from the grounds.
- Spring Grove Horse Show, Inc., the Village of Spring Grove, and all other affiliates are not responsible or liable for any injury, damages, or loss sustained in any way to exhibitors, volunteers, spectators, or properties.
- Spectators are expected to remain in designated areas.
- No hitting or abuse of horses will be tolerated.

SPEED RULES:

- No hitting forward of cinch.
- Crops allowed for riders 13 & under.
- QUIRTS EXPRESSLY PROHIBITED.
- Judges and officials reserve the right to dismiss riders for excessive whipping.
- No running through the gate area. All riders must walk through the gate.
- Riders may enter age group & all ages for classes that offer it.
- **Speed classes will be broken into pleasure and speed Divisions based on time. Pleasure is for those running their pleasure horses. The speed division will be more competitive speed riders and horses. The judge reserves the right to move you into the proper division based on your time.
- 5 sec. penalty for knocked barrels/poles. No time for dropped flag.
- ***Riders for musical sacks will dismount when music stops and continue on foot to their sack. Riders must always continue in a counter clockwise FORWARD direction. You may not go counter clockwise or backwards to reach a sack. Any rider found breaking the rules will be dismissed and not be placed.
