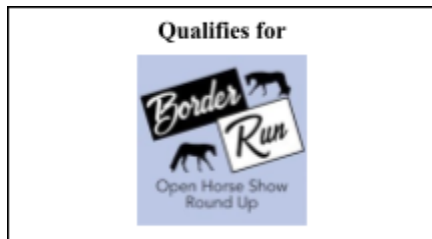

Office Fee \$5.00/number (horse/rider combo)

- Helmets are required for ages 18 and under any time the exhibitor is in the arena or mounted.
- Exhibitor age as of January 1 of the current year.
- Riders under 18 must have parent or guardian signed entry.
- Proper attire required for all English and Western classes.
- No entries taken after previous class has entered the arena.
- For classes with fewer than 5 entries, the show committee has the right to combine, cancel, or substitute classes.
- Novice classes are for horse/rider combinations who have never won a 1<sup>st</sup> place in that class, at ANY show prior to today's date.
- No trophy or year-end high points given unless there are 4 or more riders in a class.
- No hitting or abuse of horses will be tolerated.
- All horses must provide proof of a current negative Coggins.
- No stallion age 2 or over may be shown by anyone under 18.
- No alcohol.
- Dogs must be on a leash and kept away from horses.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to excuse any exhibitor, spectator, or equine from the grounds.
- Spring Grove Horse Show, Inc., the Village of Spring Grove, and all other affiliates are not responsible or liable for any injury, damages, or loss sustained in any way to exhibitors, volunteers, spectators, or properties.
- Spectators are expected to remain in designated areas.
- In case of a division tie, Showmanship class points will be used as a tie-breaker for divisional high point awards.
- \* Horse/rider combination not eligible for any other classes except trail. Classes 11, 12, 15 & 16 are for riders who do not canter/lope.
- \*\* Ranch Riding rules pertaining to tack/apparel/banding and braiding will be waived to encourage participation. The focus of the judging will be on the riding and on the ranch-style movement of the horse. Horse/Rider combinations may participate in other classes. Banding/braiding will be allowed for riders participating in classes other than Ranch.
