Send: Rider & Horse names, Class #'s, back # (if using own) & emergency contact info to horsecrazed4194@hotmail.com AT LEAST 1 WEEK PRIOR to show. ALL info MUST be received BEFORE deadline for class cards to be filled out for you! Incomplete entries and early entry changes must fill out their own cards. Come to registration to sign release forms, pay & show Coggins.

GENERAL RULES: Laid back, friendly atmosphere. **SHOW ATTIRE OPTIONAL!** Long pants & heeled boots required. Helmets strongly encouraged in all classes and required for jumping. All participants must sign liability waivers prior to mounting. Legal guardian to sign for minors. Show Coggins test at registration. \$10 office fee. **NO class refunds except early entries.** Classes under 6 entries may be combined. Trophy only awarded in classes of 3 or more. No dogs or alcohol. All classes count toward Year End if more than 1 show. Rain call made by 9 PM day before. Watch Facebook page or email above address if there is a rain question. E-mails checked until 10PM night prior. Ages as of Jan 1, 2022, **5 min allowed for tack changes. Gate can NOT be held after last call. Horse MAY be double entered in a class with different riders if group rail work is not required.** Gates open at 7:00. Arena available for warm up/jump schooling 7:30-8:30.

HIGHPOINTS: \$5 per highpoint entering (one time - not per highpoint class). TO QUALIFY MUST sign up for highpoint at entry booth and MUST enter all classes for that highpoint. Same Horse/rider combo only eligible to win 2 highpoints.

Advanced English: 1, 2, 5, (6 or 8), (12 or 13 or 14), 16 (For shared horses, different horse may be used #16)

Crossrail English: 3, 4, 7, 11, (12 or 13 or 14)

Games: 35, 36, 37, 36, (39a, b or c), 40. Speed: 42,43, 44,45,46, 47

NON JUMPING English 10, 11 (12 or 13 or 14), 19, (23 or 24), any 52. Walk/Trot: (27 or 29 or 31), (28 or 30 or 32), 33, 43a, 46a, 52

Youth Western: 19, 20, 21, (23 or 24), 50, 52 Adult Western: 17, 18, 19, (23 or 24), 50, 52 * Classes = Pepper's Legacy highpoint

PERFORMANCE CLASSES

JUMPING: Class 1&2 are pick your course. Class 3&4 are 3 lines (1 ½ times around ring- exit at exit gate, not entry gate). Mini Medal is a course which may contain advanced maneuvers like jumping without stirrups, straight-line halts etc. Open 2 Jump Line is open to everyone. Novice 2 jump line is for greener horses/newer jump riders. Please respect that. Class 8 (Jumpers) is a timed course. Jump height is 12" at center of cross rails or verticle. Jumps may be lower than height listed, not higher.

GROUND POLE CLASS: MAY BE ENTERED ENGLISH OR WESTERN pick your own course

HORSE & RIDER JUMP/RUN RELAY Rider jumps 1 fence mounted, hands horse to assistant & finishes course on foot. Timed **ENGLISH EQUITATION** is a rail class with no printed pattern.

~~**VERSATILIY:** Riders W/T/C English then line up in arena. Each rider is allowed 1 assistant who enters with their western tack. Riders/assistants have 4 min. to change tack (and apparel if desired – dress in layers) and remount. Riders not mounted at end of 4 min. are disqualified. Riders then perform walk & jog western on the rail. Different horse may be used for highpoint.

PLEASURE CLASSES: Hackamores, bit-less bridles & snaffles permitted on all ages. Western classes can ride 1 or 2 handed regardless of bit and horse's age, but must remain consistent throughout class.

++ **RANCH RIDING: TACK/ATTIRE RULES WAVED. ENTRIES MAY ENTER OTHER RIDING CLASSES.** Perform at a forward, working speed while displaying versatility, attitude & movement of a working horse. Extended jog & lope will be required.

Canter riders ARE allowed to enter class 26 to encourage Ranch participation, but may not enter class 33 for W/T riders only

OPEN TRAIL HORSE PLEASURE: Horses that don't often show- a responsive horse that is happy with his job. English/ Western

LEAD LINE: Participation ribbon. Walking only. Open to parents/adults or youth riders. **All WALK/TROT CLASSES** are intended for novice riders or green horses. Classes 27 to 33 NO PATTERN & Riders are ineligible for canter classes. Riders in 27 to 33 may also enter Class 39a, 43a, 46a Horse/rider combo ineligible for walk/trot & open of same game.

GAMES CLASSES:

BAREBACK PLEASURE & EQU: English or Western Bridles, Hackamore or halter. **BAREBACK DOLLAR:** Rail class. Judge places \$ bill under rider's legs, seat, etc. whoever holds their \$ longest wins everyone else's dollar. Bring your own dollar.

BRIBE YOUR HORSE: Using a favorite treat, exhibiter must "Persuade" horse to follow exhibiter around a cone and back.

Exhibiter CANNOT touch horse after crossing timer. Timed event. Halters strongly encouraged. Reins must be removed or tied

WATER RIDE: Walk/trot/canter rail class. Try to keep the most water in your cup.

OPEN MUSICAL STALLS: When music stops, ride FORWARD to next open stall & halt. Rider who doesn't get a stall is out.

LEAD PARENT/SPOUSE/FRIEND PLUG RUN Western saddle & release forms required for rider & leader. Single entry. Rider receives the ribbon. Lead rider around a barrel & back. Timed. **Enter either 41A or 41B .**

SPEED CLASSES #42 not to start prior to 1:00. SPEED RULES: No hitting forward of cinch. Crops allowed for riders 13 & under.

QUIRTS EXPRESSLY PROHIBITED. Judge reserves right to dismiss riders for excessive whipping. **No running in the gate.**

Riders may enter age group & open for barrels & plug. Pleasure horse speed is for those running their pleasure horse for fun. Speed horse classes are for more competitive speed riders. 5 sec. penalty for knocked barrels/poles. No time for dropped flag. **MOUNTAIN RUN:** (Plug run meets pole bending). Run around barrel, weave 3 cones and across finish. Timed.

TRAIL ARENA: 9:30 AM-1:30PM. Patterns will be posted. Readers allowed for all Classes. Bring your own helper to read.

Entries MAY practice on trail course from 8:30-9:30 AM, or at judge's discretion if no one is waiting. **NO practicing on trail if there are people waiting.** **TIMED TRAIL:** Time added for knocked, moved or missed obstacles. **Saddles are allowed for Showmanship**
