WALK-INS WELCOME, BUT SAVE PRECIOUS TIME ON SHOW MORNINGS -- ENTER EARLY!!

GENERAL RULES: Laid back, friendly atmosphere. SHOW ATTIRE OPTIONAL! Long pants & heeled boots required. Helmets strongly encouraged in all classes and required for jumping. All participants must sign liability wavers prior to mounting. Legal guardian to sign for minors. Show Coggins test at registration. \$10 office fee. NO class refunds except early entries. Classes under 6 entries may be combined. No dogs or alcohol. All classes count toward Year End if more than 1 show. Rain call made by 9 PM day before. Watch Facebook page or email above address if there is a rain question. E-mails checked until 10PM night prior. Ages as of Jan 1, 2023, 5 min allowed for tack changes. Gate can NOT be held after last call. Horse MAY be double entered in a class with different riders (including jumping and trail) if group rail work is not required. Gates open at 7:00. Arena available for warm up/jump schooling 7:30-8:30. Please clean up after your horse throughout the day and around your trailer before leaving. "Buddy" horses allowed to stand in arena

HIGHPOINTS: \$5 per highpoint entering (one time - not per highpoint class). TO QUALIFY MUST sign up for highpoint at entry booth and MUST enter all classes for that highpoint. Same Horse/rider combo only eligible to win 2 highpoints.

Advanced English: 1, 2, 5, (6 or 8), (11 or 12 or 13), 14 (For shared horses, different horse may be used #14)

Crossrail English: 3, 4, 7, 10, (11 or 12 or 13) **Walk/Trot:** (27 or 30 or 32 or 35 or 37), (28 or 31 or 33 or 36 or 38), 29, 45a, 49a, 55 **NON JUMPING English:** 10, (11 or 12 or 13), 17, (52 or 54), 55 **Games:** 40, 41, 42, (43a, b or c), 48. **Speed**: 45,46, 47,49,50,(48 or 51)

Youth Western: 17, 18, 19, 53, 55 Adult Western: 15, 16, 17, 53, 55 * Classes = Pepper's Legacy highpoint

PERFORMANCE CLASSES

JUMPING: Class 1&2 are pick your course. Class 3&4 are 3 lines (1 ½ times around ring- exit at exit gate, not entry gate). Mini Medal is a course which may contain advanced maneuvers like jumping without stirrups, straight-line halts etc. Open 2 Jump Line is open to everyone. Novice 2 jump line is for greener horses/newer jump riders. Please respect that. Class 8 (Jumpers) is a timed course. Jump height is 12" at center of cross rails or vertical. Jumps may be lower than height listed, not higher.

HORSE & RIDER JUMP/RUN RELAY Rider jumps 1 fence mounted, hands horse to assistant & finishes course on foot. Timed ENGLISH EQUITATION is a rail class. no printed pattern. ~~VERSATILIY: Riders W/T/C English then line up in arena. Each rider is allowed 1 assistant who enters with their western tack. Riders/assistants have 4 min. to change tack (and apparel if desired – dress in layers) and remount. Riders not mounted at end of 4 min. are disqualified. Riders then perform walk & jog western on the rail. Different horse may be used for highpoint.

<u>PLEASURE CLASSES: Hackamores, bit-less bridles & snaffles permitted on all ages.</u> Western classes can ride 1 or 2 handed regardless of bit and horse's age, but must remain consistent throughout class.

++ RANCH RIDING: TACK/ATTIRE RULES WAVED. ENTRIES MAY ENTER OTHER RIDING CLASSES. Perform at a forward, working speed while displaying versatility, attitude & movement of a working horse. Extended jog & lope will be required.

Canter riders ARE allowed to enter class 22 to encourage Ranch participation, but may not enter class 29 for W/T riders only OPEN TRAIL HORSE PLEASURE: Horses that don't often show- a responsive horse that is happy with his job. English/ Western LEAD LINE: Participation ribbon. Walking only. Open to parents/adults or youth riders.

WALK/TROT CLASSES: Entries in classes 22-24 MAY enter canter classes. Horse and Rider combinations in classes 25-38 may NOT enter canter pleasure classes. Class 25 and 27–38 may be entered by seasoned riders not wishing to canter or novice riders. Class 26 is for novice adults only. Spotters allowed in all w/t classes. There are no patterns for walk/trot Equ/horsemanship classes. Riders in 25-38 may enter Classes 43a, 45a, 49a. Horse/rider combo ineligible for walk/trot & open of same game. Walk trot riders will be given a brief warm up prior to the start of class 22.

GAMES CLASSES:

BAREBACK PLEASURE & EQU: English or Western Bridles, Hackamore or halter.

BRIBE YOUR HORSE: Using a favorite treat, exhibiter must "Persuade" horse to follow exhibiter around a cone and back. Exhibiter CANNOT touch horse after crossing timer. Timed event. Halters strongly encouraged. Reins must be removed or tied WATER RIDE: Walk/trot/canter rail class. Try to keep the most water in your cup.

LEAD PARENT/SPOUSE/FRIEND PLUG RUN Western saddle & <u>release forms required for rider & leader</u>. Single entry. Rider receives the ribbon. Lead rider around a barrel & back. Timed. Enter either 44A or 44B.

<u>QUIRTS EXPRESSLY PROHIBITED</u>. Judge reserves right to dismiss riders for excessive whipping. <u>No running in the gate</u>. <u>Riders may enter age group & open</u>. Pleasure horse speed is those running a pleasure horse for fun. Speed horse classes are more competitive speed riders. 5 sec. penalty knocked barrels/poles. <u>MOUNTAIN RUN</u>: Around barrel, weave 3 cones, cross finish. <u>TRAIL: 9:30-2PM Patterns will be posted. Readers allowed. Bring your own. Entries MAY practice on trail course at judge's discretion. <u>NO practicing on trail if there are people waiting.</u> <u>TIMED TRAIL</u>: Time added for knocked, moved or missed obstacles. SPLIT WT/WTC: All riders go in same class. Are then split into divisions. <u>Saddles allowed for Showmanship</u></u>
